

TB153 (Rev1) - Windows 2000/XP Patch For Offline Intercon

Overview

Some users may experience problems trying to run Intercon Offline software on a PC running Windows 2000 or Windows XP. This document contains detailed instructions on how to “patch” the Intercon executable file.

Procedure

1. Download the patch.

The required patch can be found at the following location:

<http://clio.rice.edu/djgpp/ntsbrkpat.zip>

2. Unzip the downloaded patch

Once you have downloaded the patch, you must unzip the file to the C:\CNC7 directory that Offline Intercon installed on your PC.

3. Apply the patch.

To apply the patch, you will need to go to a Command Prompt. This can be reached through the Start Menu:

Start Menu -> Programs -> Accessories -> Command Prompt

Once the command prompt opens up you will need to type the following command to apply the patch:

```
C:\CNC7\SBKRPAT.EXE INTERCON.EXE
```

Note: The space before intercon.exe, should receive a message saying the file was patched. You can now run Offline Intercon without experiencing any problems.
